Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 12. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school is not running bal-vatika presently. Thus, it is required to submit an undertaking that from upcoming session school will run bal-vatika within 03 months in the compliance.
3	As per the videography submitted, it is appearing that, wall on one side of the school is not made of concrete as it is very thin or the wall of another plot has been used as boundary wall which has been painted by the school. Thus, the school is directed to ensure that it should be bounded with proper concrete boundary wall from all sides with minimum 6 ft of height and submit the videography link covering entire boundary wall from all sides in continuity along with aerial view in the compliance within 03 months.
4	As per the Video, in the toilets height of the wall is very low, which do not allow any privacy to students. Thus, the school is required to raise the height of the said walls within 03 months and submit the compliance.

5	The workstations in the composite science lab are covered with plastics, which is not appropriate and there is no gas connection. Thus, the school is required to remove the plastics sheets and arrange the gas connection in the workstation for chemistry section within 03 months and submit the compliance.
6	There are carpets lying in some of the classrooms, which is not appropriate and there is only one chair arranged in library in teacher reading section. Thus, the school is required to remove the carpet from the classrooms and increase the seating arrangement for teachers in library in teacher's corner within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The playground / campus area is not developed, there is water logging and debris seen in the same. Thus, the school is required to clean / upgrade the playground / campus area with proper drainage system within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.
